

Sacred Heart School Kindergarten Admission Policy

The following admission policy was adopted by Sacred Heart Education Commission on March 22, 2010.

Sacred Heart School Kindergarten is open to any child who will be five years of age by September 1st of the school year for which they are enrolling, regardless of race, color or creed. Placement in the K program will determined by teacher evaluation of the child. All placement in SHK is at the principal's discretion.

Further, and above this, the policy adopted by the Education Commission reads that admission will be subject to the following:

- 1. Priority will be given in the following order:
 - a. Children of parents who are parishioners of Sacred Heart Church or any parent that has other children attending Sacred Heart School.
- 2. All tuition and fees need to be current and registration and book fees must be paid at the time of registration.

The above priority list will only apply for two weeks after the start of registration. Any late registrations will be place upon a waiting list and will receive a telephone call is a position for your child becomes available.

A copy of your child's birth certificate and a completed health history and physical examination are required. Both sides of the green health appraisal must be filled out completely by August 20.
